

WEEK 2: Seek – Google or Bible?

Objective:

To examine what we can trust in books and online when exploring the truth in the Bible.

Ask:

How did you find out about Matthew in the past week? Using which books, websites, or tools?

Can we trust everything on Google, Wikipedia, etc.?

Shall we limit our searches for Biblical truth to trusted Bible websites, such as Bible Gateway, etc.?

#Bible, but where?

Seek:

Will you search up something you wish to know? Are you satisfied with textbook answers?

“The best way to learn a new thing is to relate what you already know to extend your knowledge”, such as new video games & K-Pop dances.

Can you share something you found in the past that you think you can trust or cannot trust?

Knock:

In case you don't understand something in the Bible, will you simply search it in the library or online?

In case you cannot find a satisfactory answer, will you ask your Sunday school teacher?

If we have so many resources helping us understand the Bible, shall you start reading the Bible?

“Reading the Bible takes time.” That's right, shall we start this week?

Students are required to start reading Matthew as much as they can before the next lesson.

Assessing the Lesson:

No one can read the Bible for us and no one can take the Bible away from us. Do teachers awaken the desire to seek God through the scriptures in students?
