WEEK 3: Knock – Let's Not just "Read" the Bible

Objective:

To encourage students to be aware of Biblical truth in their daily lives and in media.

Ask:

YouTube is full of stuff, but what do you treasure?

Have you ever found any good spiritual insights from media?

"speaking to one another with <u>psalms, hymns, and songs</u> from the Spirit. <u>Sing and make music</u> from your heart to the Lord"

#Bible, but where?

Seek:

Can you find songs and movies of hidden Bible treasures on YouTube? Let's "sing" the Bible, make music to the Lord. Shall we share our spiritual treasures?

Three times a year all your men must appear before the Lord your God at the place he will choose: at the Festival of Unleavened Bread, the Festival of Weeks and the Festival of Tabernacles. No one should appear before the Lord empty-handed: Each of you must bring a gift in proportion to the way the Lord your God has blessed you.

#Bible, but where?

Knock:

Students are required to bring a song or a movie that they can relate to what they have read in the Bible.

Students are encouraged to share their spiritual treasures like bringing gifts to God in a festival.

Assessing the Lesson:

Teachers will show students that Biblical stories and truth can be found in the media. They may then share personal experiences in God with the students.
